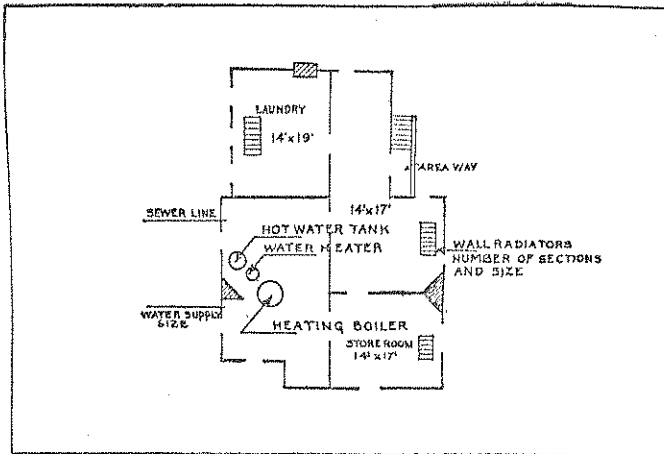
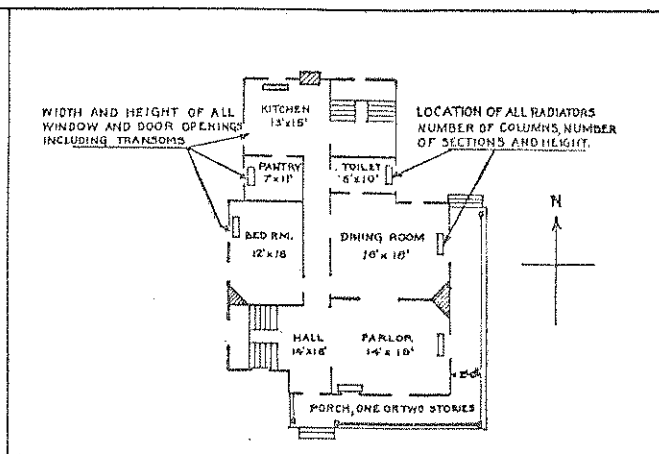


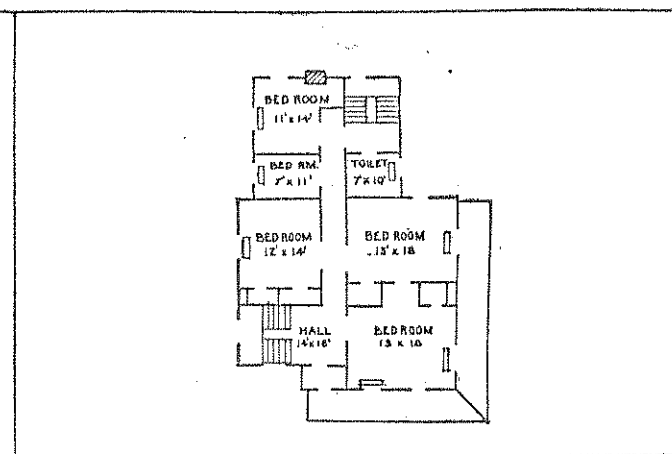

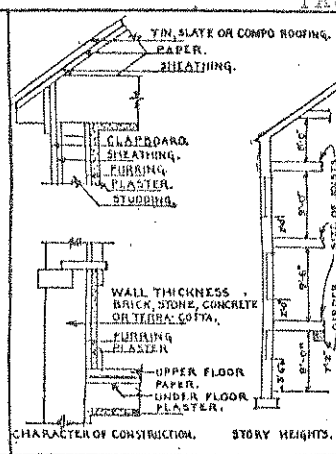

FIRST FLOOR

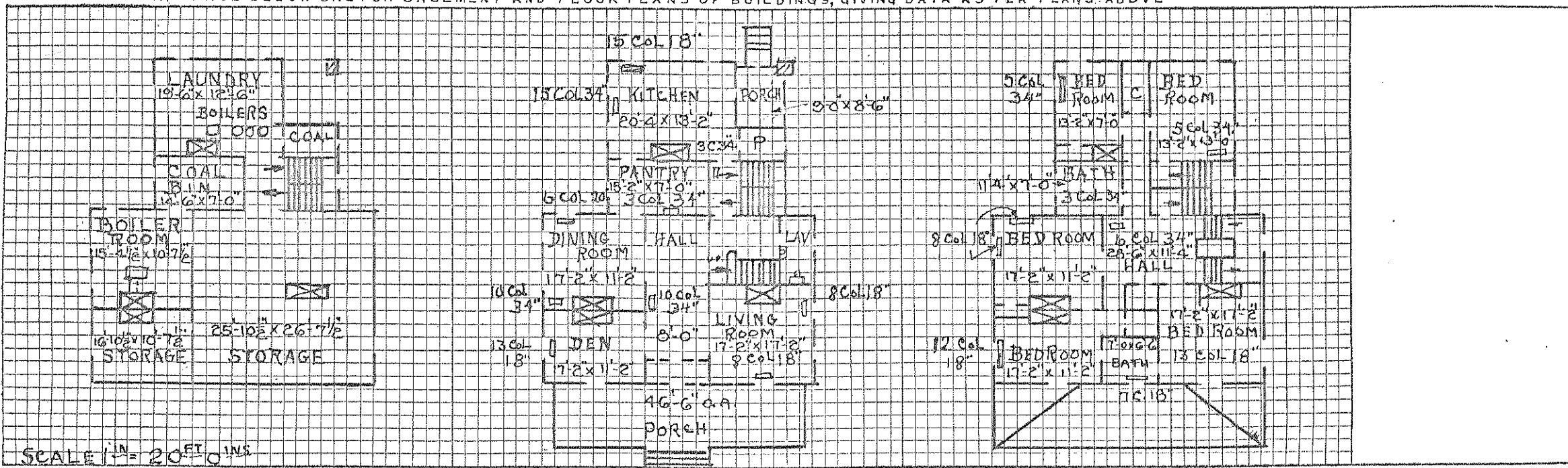


SECOND FLOOR
